

Important information regarding your application

It is important that the form is filled in completely, including all financial information, otherwise we may have to refer back to you for clarification.

The charity would consider your application if you live within **RG30 or RG31 postcodes or in Theale.**

A **supporting letter** is also required and this can be from an individual such as a Social Worker, Housing Support or Resettlement Officer, Occupational Therapist, Health Visitor, District Nurse, GP or Probation Officer. Also charities such as Citizens' Advice Bureau, Launchpad etc.

Other charities that may be able to offer similar support:
